

Park City Presbyterian, Knoxville, Knox County, TN

The Park City Presbyterian Church at 2204 Linden Avenue was originally built as a frame “Carpenter Gothic” church building in the late 19th century. After a fire, the church was expanded, remodeled, and a brick exterior was added. Magnificent stained glass windows, many of them World War I memorials, are throughout the sanctuary including a few surviving leaded glass windows from before the fire. The congregation of this now inner-city church diminished and dispersed, resulting in the building becoming vacant. Recognizing the significance of this building and its potential as an asset to the community, several organizations came together to save and see to its reuse. The Park City Community Organization, 4 Market Square, Knoxville Fellows, the Park City Sanctuary organization, and the newly formed Park City Presbyterian Restoration organization have set out to see that this historic building returns to active community service.
