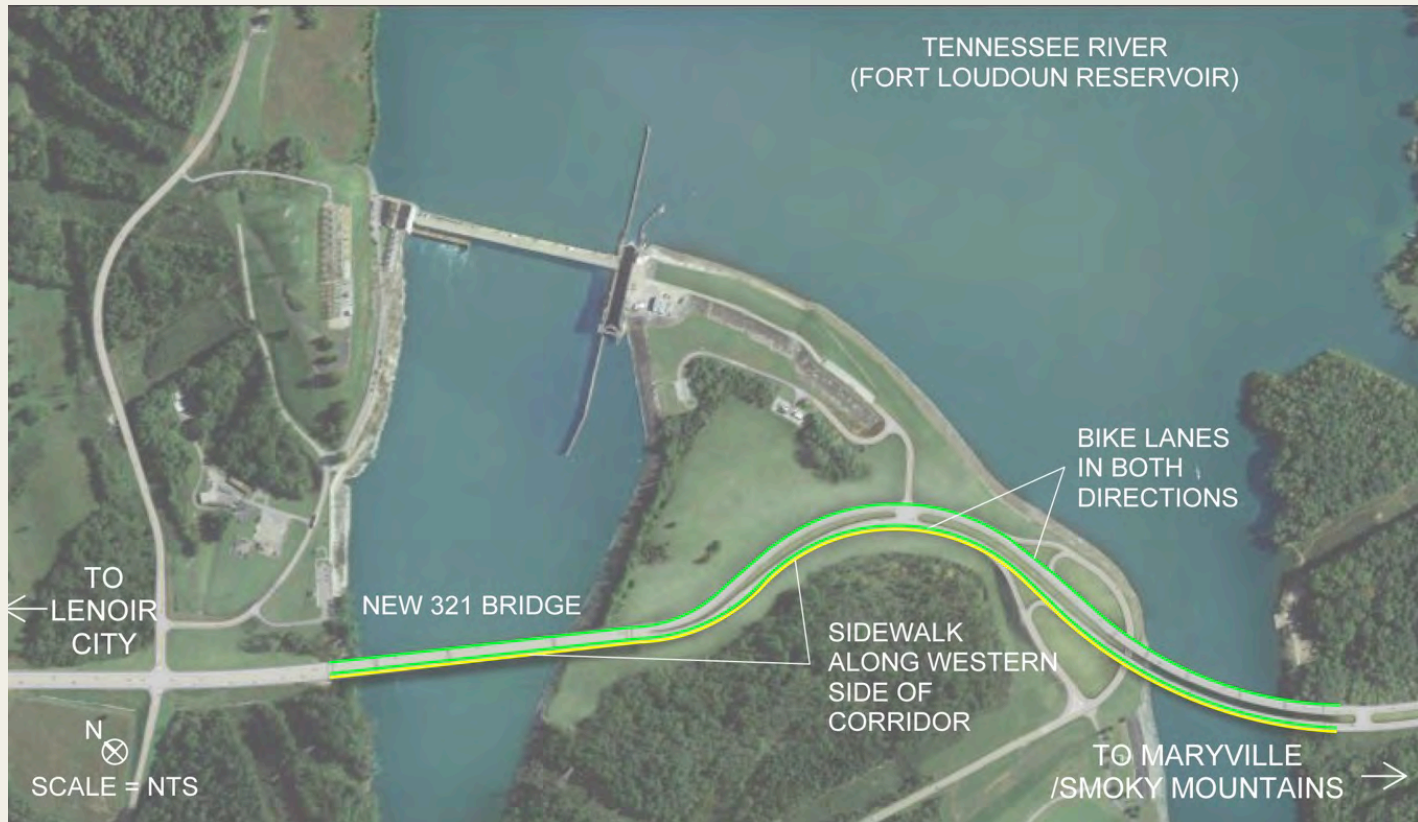

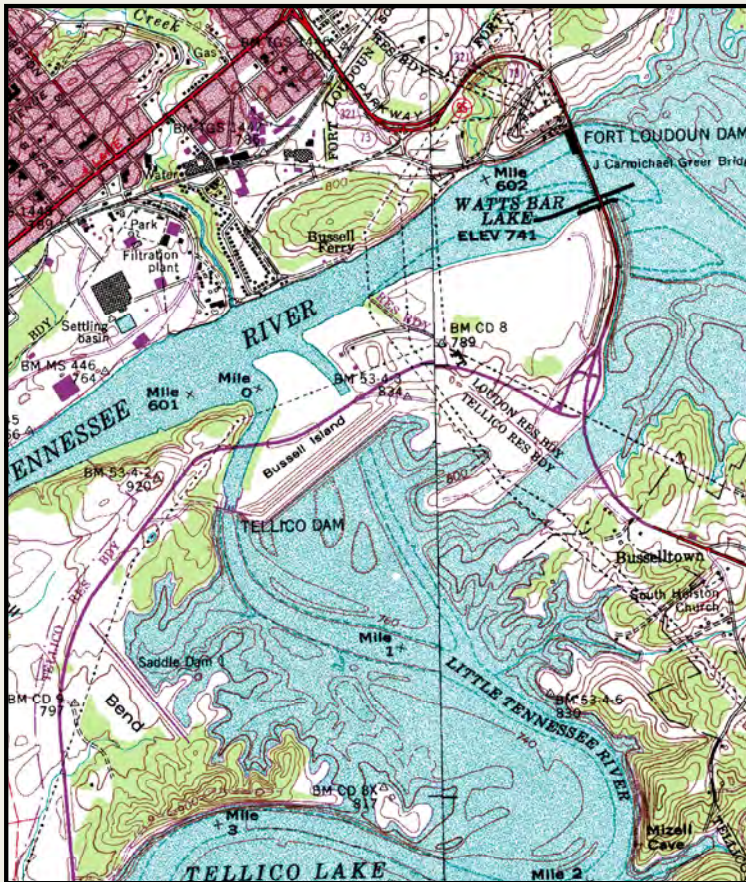
TDOT Updates

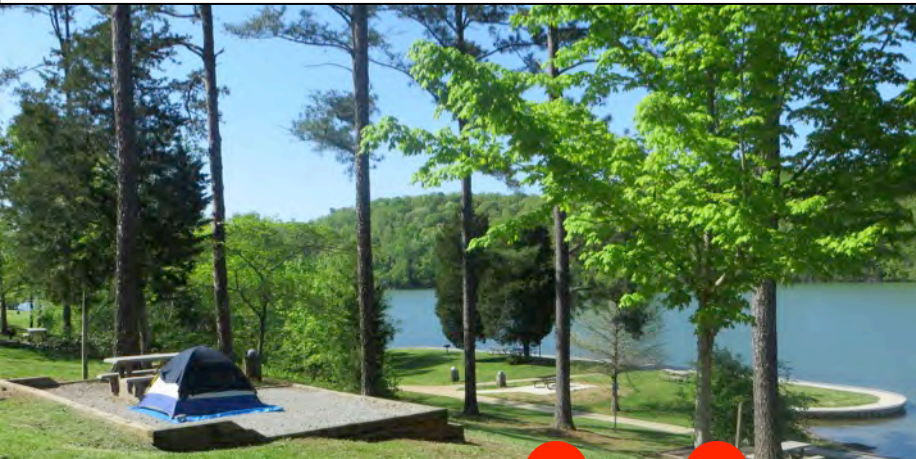
